### Job Purpose

To manage the Swindon area specialist advisory service for children and young people who are deaf, working in partnership with families and young people, education settings, health, care and voluntary services to improve outcomes for children and young people with special educational needs and disability.

### Key Accountabilities

- To enable and empower families, young people and universal providers to identify needs relating to hearing impairment and take early effective graduated action to meet those needs within a well informed and skilled approach.
- To work with education settings to review the effectiveness of interventions and environmental adaptations designed to enable children and young people with needs related to hearing impairment to make progress and succeed.
- To support planning and preparing for transition through appropriate information sharing regarding needs and options.
- To contribute to the planning and delivery of special education provision for a child or young person where, despite relevant and purposeful action, additional strategies, equipment, programmes or other interventions, the child or young person with needs relating to hearing impairment has not made the expected progress.
- To monitor, review and report on the effectiveness of the hearing support and advisory service in delivery to agreed outcomes and supporting improved outcomes for children and young people with special educational needs and disability and to take a lead for the service development plan
- Advise the LA on strategies and policies to meet the educational needs of deaf children and young people in Swindon.
- Advise the LA and schools on resources and centrally funded specialist audiological equipment required, and oversee their distribution, maintenance, loan and effective use.
- To provide effective line management and supervision of service staff.

- To ensure specialist advice and contribution to Local Authority statutory processes and responsibilities.
- To ensure at least annual monitoring and support visits from a teacher of the deaf for all Swindon children and young people placed outside the Borough with Education, Health and Care Plans who have deafness as a primary need.
- Delegated budgetary responsibilities.

- Understanding of the Children and Families Act 2014 in relation to children and young people with SEND and hearing impairment specifically

- Strong organisational skills with the ability to work under tight deadlines with conflicting priorities
- Ability to work successfully as part of a team
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills and ability to write clear and concise reports and presentations

- Able to work through problems, evaluate risks and provide creative solutions
- Effective interpersonal skills to consult, influence and negotiate to produce successful outcomes
